Therapists will participate in an interactive demonstration of myosite training and testing.

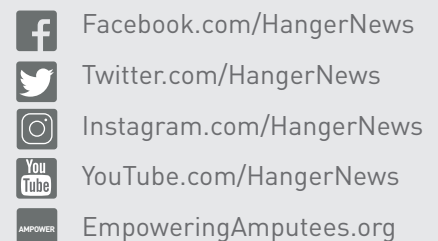
